Welcome

Hello. Welcome to Collegiate Milan North for this new academic year.

We are really looking forward to welcoming you to Collegiate Milan North in a few weeks.

To ensure you have all the information you need before you move in, we have put together some helpful guidelines.

You will be able to book a time slot on the online portal, and you will be given information on how to do this by email. If you need to move in outside these dates or outside the time slots available, please contact our residence team directly to arrange your arrival.

Travelling to Collegiate Milan North

If you need advice on how to get to your accommodation by public transport or help with the closest car park, please contact milannorth@collegiate-ac.eu and the Accommodation Team will be able to help.

1. Car parking

There is an underground car parking at Collegiate Milan North.

The parking will be available to students and parents on moving-in day only. Please advise the Accommodation Team you will need access to the parking before your arrival.

2. Luggage

Please note that luggage cannot be sent to the residence in advance of your arrival as we do not have any storage room for luggage. You will need to bring your belongings on moving-in day.

3. Local accommodation

If you are arriving at Collegiate Milan North outside of office opening hours or with members of your family, there are some local accommodation options available to you. A few options to consider are:

- Hilton Garden Inn Milan North, Via Lucio Giunio Columella 36, Milan, distance from Collegiate Milan North 750m
- AC Hotel by Marriott Milan Sesto, Via Luciano Lama 10, Milan, distance from Collegiate Milan North 1,2km
- Il Girasole High Quality Inn, Via Doberdò 19, Milan, distance from Collegiate Milan North 400m
- La Cadrega B&B, Via Pericle 2, Milan, distance from Collegiate Milan North 600m
- Bed and Breakfast La Fornasetta, Via Ernesto Breda 86, Milan, distance from Collegiate Milan North 400m
- Abacus Hotel, Via Monte Grappa 39, Sesto San Giovanni, distance from Collegiate Milan North 3km

4. Check-in

To make your check-in process as smooth as possible, you will be required to provide and view the following documentation on your Collegiate Portal:

- Sign your Accommodation Agreement
- Send copies of your identification documents
- Pay your rent amount as per your contract
- Read your Welcome Information
- Confirm your phone number at reception - make sure WhatsApp is active on your number
- Save residence phone number in your address book

4.1 Allocated check-in slots

You will be able to reserve a time slot for check-in: slots will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.

4.2 Check-in at your accommodation

On the day and time booked for check-in, you will be given the keys to enter your new home.

Ensure to carry out an initial inventory of your room within 7 days from your check-in date via the “Inventory & Inspections” section of your personal profile on Collegiate portal. Please remember to report any damage or anomalies already present in your room, to avoid any charges for restoration and repair costs at the end of your stay.

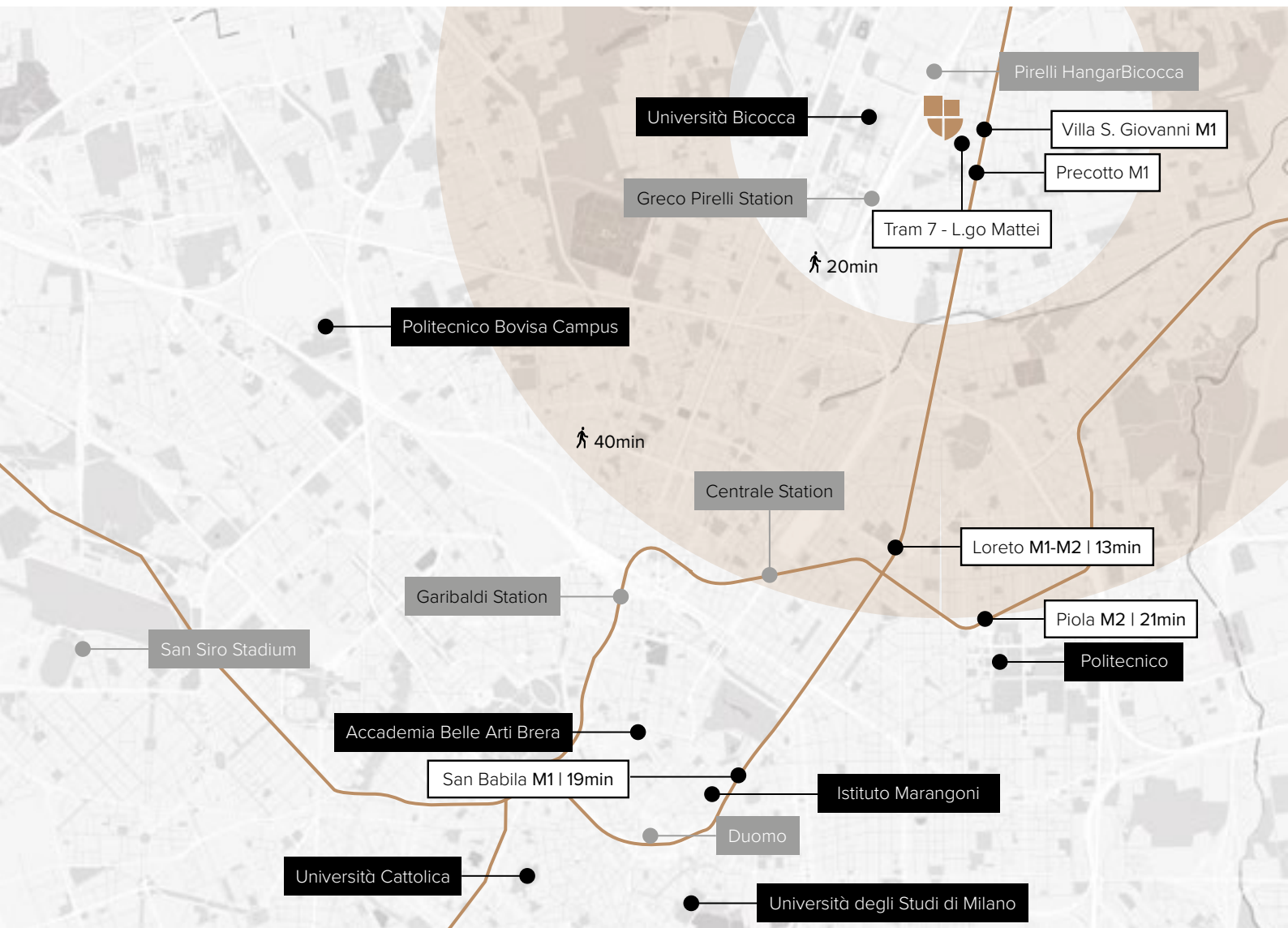
6. Student Experience

Moving in requirements

Please ensure that, before you move in, you have completed the following through the Collegiate Portal:

- Paid your 500€ deposit
- Paid your first rental instalment, or full rent if applicable. Please be aware, no keys will be issued to you if rent has not been paid
- Provided x1 photo ID and x1 proof of address, for yourself and your guarantor if applicable; x1 proof of student status (compulsory in case of Club Room and Superior Club Room)
- Read and accepted the gym, swimming pool, spa, parcel and fire procedures

If you have not done this prior to move in, you **MUST** bring all these with you on the day of your arrival. Without complete documentation, you will not be able to check-in.

No keys will be issued if a resident has not satisfied any of the above requirements.
